The number of cumulative positive persons tested locally includes the 85 persons from the fishing vessel American Triumph and the 1 person employed on the State Ferry Tustumena, who all left the island shortly after testing.

COVID-19 VACCINE PLANNING: State DHSS and the Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium are working jointly to develop a statewide plan for distribution of a vaccine for COVID-19, even though a vaccine isn't yet available. A vaccine may be available before the end of the year, and will mostly likely be made available initially to healthcare workers, staff and residents of long term care facilities, critical infrastructure workforce and people at increased risk for severe illness with COVID-19.
