COVID VACCINE ELIGIBILITY: State DHSS announced yesterday that all individuals 16 years and above who live or work in Alaska are now eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine. If you are 16+ and have been waiting to get immunized, it's your turn! If you are 16 or 17 years old, you will need to make an appointment for the Pfizer vaccine. That is the only vaccine authorized by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration for that age group. Moderna and the Johnson & Johnson Janssen vaccines are authorized for individuals 18 years or older. Call the IHFS Clinic at 581-1202 or the Q-Tribe at 581-2920 to make your appointment.
