COVID VACCINE ELIGIBILITY: *Everyone 16 years and older who lives or works in Alaska is now eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine. If you are 16 or older and want to be immunized, it's your turn! If you are 16 or 17 years old, you will need to make an appointment for the Pfizer vaccine. That is the only vaccine authorized by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration for that age group. Moderna and the Johnson & Johnson Janssen vaccines are authorized for individuals 18 years or older.*
