LOCAL RISK FACTOR: High.

CITY OF UNALASKA COVID-19 CASE COUNT: There are still no confirmed cases of coronavirus in Unalaska. The clinic expects results on two of the three tests very soon. All patients with pending test results are doing fine.

STATE OF ALASKA COVID-19 CASE COUNT: There are 119 confirmed cases in the state as of yesterday.

UNALASKA PUBLIC LIBRARY DROP BOX: The drop box is no longer available at the library because we've loaned the drop box to the school for students to return school work. Library patrons will not be charged overdue fees for items that could not be returned because of the library closure.

EDUCATING INCOMING TRAVELERS: Starting tomorrow, Unalaska Public Safety Personnel will meet all incoming airport passengers to provide information about the State's mandatory 14-day quarantine.

RAVN AIR GROUP: On March 24 we reported that Ravn would reduce their flights between Anchorage and Unalaska to 9 flights per week. Due to a dramatic and continued reduction in passengers because of COVID-19, Ravn has been forced to further reduce their schedule by 50%. It is anticipated that Ravn will offer approximately four flights per week between Anchorage and Unalaska/Dutch Harbor. The City of Unalaska is working with the State Department of Transportation and FAA to ensure long term air service for Unalaska/Dutch Harbor.
