**UPDATE LOCAL TO MANDATE TO BE CONSIDERED CITY COUNCIL:** On Tuesday, March 23 the Unalaska City Council will consider a revised mandate related to COVID-19. The City Manager is proposing, due to updated guidance provided by the CDC, the removal of the 3-month window exempting fully vaccinated individuals from the traveler quarantine, meaning that individuals fully vaccinated will <u>not</u> need to self-quarantine following travel and the exemption will no longer be limited to three months after vaccination. The City Manager is also suggesting removal of the three passenger limit for taxicabs. The meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, March 23, at 6:00 p.m.
