Friday, May 14, 2021, 3:15pm, News Release no. 226 *Coronavirus COVID-19*

Earlier this week, the Centers for Disease Control provided guidance for individuals who are fully vaccinated against COVID-19, stating those who are fully vaccinated can resume pre-pandemic activities without wearing a face covering or staying six feet apart from others, except where required by federal, state, local, tribal or territorial rules and regulations, including business and workplace guidance.

Locally, the City of Unalaska's mandate is still in force, which requires all customers and visitors of businesses and organizations that are open and operating to wear coverings over the nose and mouth to provide additional protection for employees and customers. Additionally, employees and volunteers of open businesses and organizations must wear coverings over the nose and mouth when interacting with customers and visitors.

The current local mandate is Resolution 2021-28, and is available from the City Clerk and on the city website at https://www.ci.unalaska.ak.us/citymanager/page/local-mandates.

The City Council will next consider the local mandate at their 6pm meeting on Tuesday, May 25, 2021, at City Hall. The Mayor and Council welcome input from community members and everyone is encouraged to attend meetings of the City Council, whether in person, by ZOOM or telephone. Public comment can be provided in person at the meeting, by telephone or ZOOM. Notify the City Clerk if you'd like to provide comment using ZOOM features, or pressing *9 by telephone. Written comment is accepted by the City Clerk up to one hour before the meeting begins, which will be read during the meeting.
