FROM THE STATE DHSS WEEKLY REPORT:

- COVID vaccines are highly effective at protecting you from getting sick
- 98% of all hospitalizations in Alaska to date were people who are unvaccinated
- In our region, Aleutian West Census Area, 58.1% of everyone age 16 and over have received their first dose of the vaccine; and 39.1% of the population is fully vaccinated
- Anyone who lives or works in Alaska is eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine, including children age 12 and over
