#### LOCAL RISK FACTOR: HIGH

Unalaska Unified Command is raising the community COVID-19 Risk Level to **HIGH**. This change is due to two newly identified community acquired cases of COVID-19. Four additional recent cases have also been identified, three of which traveled recently and one which is industry-related. Through the upsurge in cases, widespread community exposure has been confirmed. Additionally, wastewater testing recently showed a significant spike in COVID-19 positivity.

The IFHS Clinic is presently able to maintain their standard of care for all patients, but hospitals in Anchorage are becoming overloaded, contributing to diversion of transferring patients. The alert level for most of the State of Alaska is high.

In Alaska and nationwide, 97% of new cases of COVID-19 are the Delta Variant, which is 2-3 times more transmissible and is infecting both vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals. However, vaccinated individuals have a lower probability of infection, much milder illness, and avoid hospitalization and death at a much higher rate than unvaccinated individuals.

Unalaska Unified Command **STRONGLY** encourages increased personal protective measures in order to avoid a large outbreak in the community:

- Wash Your Hands Frequently
- Don't Touch Face with Unwashed Hands
- Wear Face Covering in Public
- Cover Coughs & Sneezes
- Keep 6 feet from Other People
- Keep Your Social Circle Small
- Avoid Contact with Sick Persons
- When Sick, Stay Home

- Watch for Symptoms & Get Tested if you Develop Symptoms
- <u>Avoid</u>: large gatherings; being in enclosed spaces with others; long interactions with non-household members; being around forceful exhalations like yelling & singing
- Clean & Disinfect Surfaces Daily
- Limit Interactions After Traveling as this is a very high risk activity at this time

The Unalaska City Council is scheduled to review community-wide protective measures at their regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, August 24. By that time, our local health care providers and Incident Commanders will have more information about potential community spread following last weekend's events, and results of further wastewater testing.

**COVID VACCINE:** The State vaccine dashboard for the Aleutians West Region shows 73% of the population age 12 and over with at least their first dose of the vaccine, an increase from 70% at the end of July; and 60% of the population fully vaccinated. Vaccines continue to be available through both the IFHS and APIA clinics.

**CITY FACILITIES:** In order to protect the health and wellbeing of our employees and first responders, and to help stop a potential local outbreak of cases, many city facilities will be open by appointment only starting tomorrow, August 18. Occupancy limits have been developed for PCR facilities and reservations are required. Each facility has developed COVID-19 protective measures for the benefit of both our employees and the community we serve. The following table provides a brief overview of the hours of availability.
