LOCAL RISK FACTOR: High.

CITY OF UNALASKA COVID-19 CASE COUNT: There are 0 confirmed cases of coronavirus in Unalaska.

STATE OF ALASKA COVID-19 CASE COUNT: There are 345 confirmed cases in the state.

STATE AND LOCAL MANDATES: On Saturday April 25 the State of Alaska updated 8 of the attachments to Mandate #16. Unalaska's local "mandate" (Resolution 2020-19) remains in effect until April 29, 2020. Tomorrow evening, the Unalaska City Council will consider whether to continue or modify local emergency protective orders. Everyone is encouraged to listen in on local KUCB Channel 8 or Radio Station 89.7, or call into the meeting.
