LOCAL RISK FACTOR: Medium

CITY OF UNALASKA COVID-19 CASE COUNT: There are 0 confirmed cases in Unalaska.

STATE OF ALASKA COVID-19 CASE COUNT: There are 387 confirmed cases in the state, with 339 people recovered.

AIR TRAVEL: Beginning May 16, regularly scheduled passenger air service is available between Anchorage and Dutch Harbor, via Cold Bay, two days per week, Wednesday and Saturday. The Anchorage to Cold Bay leg can be scheduled with Alaska Airlines, which looks to be a 90 minute flight, and the Cold Bay to Dutch Harbor leg can be scheduled with Grant Aviation and appears to be a 60 minute flight. Booking must be done separately as the two airlines are not code share partners, and online booking is available. The Alaska Airlines mileage program is available on the ANC-CDB leg.
