Coronavirus COVID-19

The Unalaska Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) will partially re-open beginning Tuesday, May 26, 2020, at 29 Safety Way (the Public Safety building):

- Hours 9:00 am to 4:00 pm
- **By appointment only - call 581-2833 to make an appointment**
- Clients must observe strict COVID-19 protective protocols which will be explained when you make your appointment
- One person at a time allowed; do not bring friends, family or children
- Wait in the Public Safety parking lot until you receive a text or call for your appointment
- To begin, we will process renewals for EXPIRED Alaska Drivers Licenses and ID cards; after expired documents are renewed, we will begin accepting appointments for new licenses and ID cards, vehicle registrations and title services
- **Please come prepared with all necessary documents to accomplish your renewal**
 - U.S. Citizens: bring the expired license or ID
 - Non-US Citizens: bring the expired license or ID, your Social Security Card and your Green Card
 - If you are on a work Visa program: bring the expired license or ID, Passport with Visa, the I-94, and Social Security Card
- **If you are renewing a CDL, bring the following documents**
 - Expired license
 - Social Security Card
 - Current Medical Certificate
 - Two documents with your name and physical address that match
 - Citizens: U.S. Passport or U.S. Birth Certificate
 - Non-citizens: Green Card
 - If your CDL has a Hazmat Endorsement you must pass the Hazmat written test and receive a TSA Approval Letter BEFORE your renewal attempt
