LOCAL QUARANTINE ORDER: The local quarantine order is in effect until June 10. On June 9 council will consider whether to continue the quarantine order. The local order requires 14 days of self-quarantine and symptom monitoring for anyone traveling into the City of Unalaska, whether by air or sea.

- Critical workforce employees must quarantine immediately upon arrival unless their employer has filed the required protective plan; employees must comply with their employer's plan
- Critical workforce employees are required to quarantine during non-work hours for the first 14 days
- Travelers (including ferry passengers) whose final destination is not Unalaska/Dutch Harbor are required to quarantine during their stopover in Unalaska/Dutch Harbor; and not required to stay here for 14 days
- Alaska Marine Highway System "day travelers" are exempt from quarantine during their stopover in Unalaska/Dutch Harbor, but must wear a face covering while visiting local businesses and adhere to six-foot social distancing guidelines
- Rules for quarantine:
 - o Leave quarantine location only for medical care
 - o Do not visit any public places such as stores, restaurants, bars, recreational facilities, etc.
 - o Do not allow visitors in designated quarantine location other than health care providers
 - o If other people live in your quarantine location, comply with six foot social distancing; sanitize regularly touched surfaces; follow CDC best practices for hand washing

LIMITED CITY FACILITY REOPENING JUNE 1: Starting June 1, city operations will return to full staffing, though some divisions will continue staggered shifts and some facilities are by appointment only. Hours may be modified, and occupancy limits have been developed for PCR facilities, so reservations are recommended. Each facility has developed COVID-19 protective measures for the benefit of both our employees and the community we serve.
