TAKE ACTION TO PROTECT YOURSELF AND OTHERS: This virus is still with us, and we cannot become complacent! CLARIFICATION: In yesterday's News Release, we shared that there were differences between the industry quarantine and testing requirements in Washington as compared to Alaska. We'd like to provide one additional clarification, Washington State **does not** have an industry mandate that requires quarantine and testing, but rather it is determined by the individual organizations. Vessels coming to Alaska, however, must follow the state mandates that require 14-day quarantining and COVID testing.
