#### **UNALASKA COVID-19 CASE COUNT:**

Patients tested in Unalaska	365
Positive Tests	8

The one additional positive COVID-19 test reported today is an employee of Icicle Seafoods and part of the original group of 38 quarantined employees who arrived on May 27. That brings the total positive tests among Icicle employees to 7. These individuals remain in quarantine and all guidance from the State of Alaska has been implemented. The 8<sup>th</sup> positive test was from the employee of the state ferry system who departed Unalaska on June 6 after testing positive.

**RULES FOR QUARANTINE:** Unalaska's local mandate requires persons traveling into the city, whether by vessel or airplane, to quarantine for 14 days upon arrival and monitor for symptoms of illness. Anyone who is required to self-quarantine must adhere to the following:

- Leave quarantine location only for medical emergencies or to seek medical care.
- Do not visit any public spaces (stores, pools, meeting rooms, fitness centers, restaurants, etc.).
- Do not allow visitors in or out of your quarantine location other than medical care providers or those authorized to enter by Unified Command.
- Comply with all rules related to your quarantine as set forth by your hotel or rented lodging.
- If there are others living in your quarantine location, comply with social distancing guidelines, sanitize regularly touched surfaces, and follow CDC best practices for hand washing.

For those people in the "critical workforce" exception of the local mandate:

- Follow all quarantine rules if your employer has not filed the protective plans as required by the local mandate; and
- Quarantine during non-working hours for the first 14 days after arrival in Unalaska.
