## LOCAL RISK FACTOR: Medium

Pursuant to the City's Guidelines for Social Distancing, our risk factor has been raised to "medium" because of the three cases confirmed within the state. There are still no confirmed cases in Unalaska. The city has already implemented the social distancing measures of the medium risk factor because of school closures and other governmental mandates. This includes the cancellation of city-sponsored gatherings and city employee travel; expansion of the Emergency Operations Center; encouraging limitation of large gatherings; and supporting protective measures for residents of the senior center. Community and industry are encouraged to cancel nonessential travel and continue to practice good hand-washing, cleaning, disinfecting and recommended social distancing measures.

CITY OF UNALASKA COVID-19 CASE COUNT: The local clinic has tested two patients for coronavirus (total). The first test was NEGATIVE and the result of the second test is pending. No confirmed cases on the island as of today.

STATE OF ALASKA COVID-19 CASE COUNT: The two new confirmed cases in the state are located in Fairbanks and both individuals had traveled in the Lower 48.
