#### **ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT**

Wanetta Ayers is the Executive Director of the Southwest Alaska Municipal Conference (SWAMC), a federally recognized Economic Development District (EDD) and Alaska Regional Development Organization (ARDOR) serving over fifty communities across the Alaska Peninsula, Aleutian Chain, Bristol Bay, Kodiak Archipelago, and Pribilof Islands. Her role focuses on economic development strategy, place marketing, workforce development, and small business and tourism support.

Ayers holds a Bachelor of Business Administration from the University of Alaska Fairbanks, an MBA from the University of Washington, and graduate certificates in economic development and social media marketing. She was born and raised in Anchorage, where four generations of her family reside, and has lived and worked across Alaska — from Juneau and Kenai to Utgiagvik.

In 2021, she was appointed to the Alaska Marine Highway Operations Board (AMHOB) and currently serves as its Chair, with her current term lasting through July 1, 2030. Her previous gubernatorial appointments include roles on the Alaska Tourism Marketing Council, the Marine Transportation Advisory Board, and the Alaska Marine Highway Reshaping Working Group.

#### **EDUCATION LUNCH: OPEN TO THE PUBLIC**

School funding has been a major issue in Alaska for several years. This fiscal year, the state's budget constraints have further limited available resources, and ongoing discussions about education funding have underscored the inadequacy of support for our schools. Join Unalaska City School District (UCSD) Superintendent Kim Hanisch and other UCSD representatives as they provide an overview of educational funding trends in Alaska, highlight the impacts of inadequate funding felt at UCSD, and strategize ways to turn the boat to stay afloat.

#### **BASIC INVESTING**

The Alaska Permanent Capital Management (APCM) presentation will provide high level thoughts on investing that are used at the institutional level that can be used for personal use. Learning Outcomes include: Investment Goals and Objectives, Importance of Investing, Retirement, Types of Investments

Bill started at APCM in 2002 and has spent his 23+ year career at APCM. Mr. Lierman was elevated to CEO in April 2025. He continues to be responsible for fixed income investments and strategies at APCM. He has 20 years of experience in risk management analytics and working with public and private sector clients.

He holds a BBA from Western Washington University and is a Chartered Financial Analyst.

#### **TOURISM**

Join Katherine McGlashan for a presentation on the issues related to tourism in Unalaska. Katherine McGlashan is an Unangan from the Aleutian Islands. She has been the Executive Director of the Unalaska Visitors Bureau for 3 years. She has obtained her 'Cultural and Heritage Tourism' certification from George Washington University in 2023. Her passion to put Unangan Culture in the forefront in tourism is to educate guests of their rich history for those that visit Unalaska and our region from all over the world, and also to show tourists how our past and present lives intertwine.

# UCSD 2025-26 SCHOOL YEAR HIGHLIGHT: OPEN TO THE PUBLIC

Unalaska City School District (UCSD) Superintendent Kim Hanisch will present highlights for the upcoming UCSD school year and also introduce the community to new UCSD staff.



#### LOCAL HEALTH CARE

Join staff members of Iliuliuk Family Health Services (IFHS) and Aleutian Pribilof Islands Association (APIA) as they present on their respective organizations and how they are working to meet the health care needs of Unalaska. City of Unalaska Fire Chief Ben Knowles will then moderate a discussion and provide opportunities for the audience to ask questions.

#### **LEGISLATIVE ROUND TABLE & LUNCHEON**

Hear from state lawmakers, including Bryce Edgmon, Lyman Hoffman, and others, for engaging discussions of state legislative issues that affect the Aleutians. There will be two sessions: a round table followed by a luncheon. Audience members will be given opportunities to ask questions and engage with their legislators following the presentations.

#### **ELDER FRAUD**

The FBI Elder Fraud presentation provides information to community partners on the common frauds and scams impacting elderly Alaskans, ways to detect fraud, and the necessary resources to report it.

#### **SEXTORTION**

The FBI Internet Safety/Sextortion presentation provides information to community partners on the risks associated with youth being online, how to navigate online spaces safely, and indicators of the Sextortion threat.

# FRONTLINE IN THE ALEUTIANS: FIRE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES IN UNALASKA, ALASKA

This presentation highlights the realities of delivering pre-hospital EMS and fire services in Unalaska, Alaska. Operating with limited staffing, no mutual aid partners, and tight funding in an isolated location presents significant challenges. Despite these hardships, our personnel and community have shown exceptional resilience, overcoming obstacles through innovation, adaptability, and strong local networks. The presentation concludes with a call for legislative action to support recruitment, retention, funding, and policies that strengthen our ability to protect lives, sustain the economy, and safeguard the infrastructure critical to remote Alaskan communities.

#### **REGIONAL ENERGY**

Join speakers Laresa Syverson, Magnus De Witt, ACEP, and Dolores Gregory for an engaging presentation on regional energy possibilities and challenges and what the future may hold for Unalaska.

#### SHIPPING

Dylan Faber with Matson will provide insights into regional shipping.

#### **BROWNFIELDS**

Addressing Formerly Used Defense Sites (FUDS), Brownfields, and Environmental Hazards in Unalaska and the Aleutian Islands. This session will inform the public about ongoing efforts to identify hazardous materials around Unalaska, discuss what the future of clean-up programs may look like in Unalaska and the Aleutian Chain, and give an overview of the history of brownfields identification efforts in Unalaska.

#### NONPROFIT PANEL

Nonprofit organizations in Unalaska are essential to the health, education, and cultural life of the community. From youth development to cultural preservation to crisis response, these organizations deliver critical services — often with tight budgets, volunteer labor, and significant operational constraints. As costs rise and staff capacity remains limited, many nonprofits are reconsidering their funding models and long-term sustainability. Despite these challenges, local nonprofits regularly collaborate, share resources, and support one another to ensure services remain available to the community. This panel brings together practitioners from across Unalaska's nonprofit sector to share firsthand experiences, common challenges, and innovative strategies for organizational resilience. Panelists will also discuss the possibility of developing a local Community Foundation to provide long-term support for essential services beyond the scope of annual city funding.
