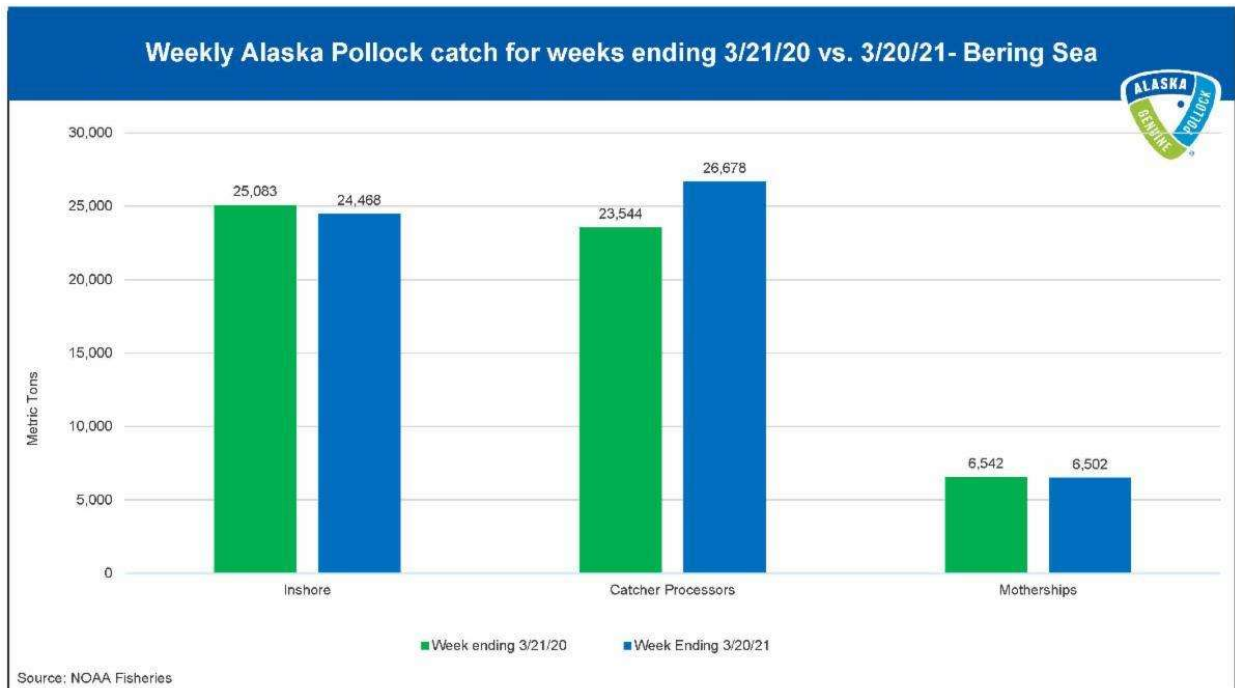

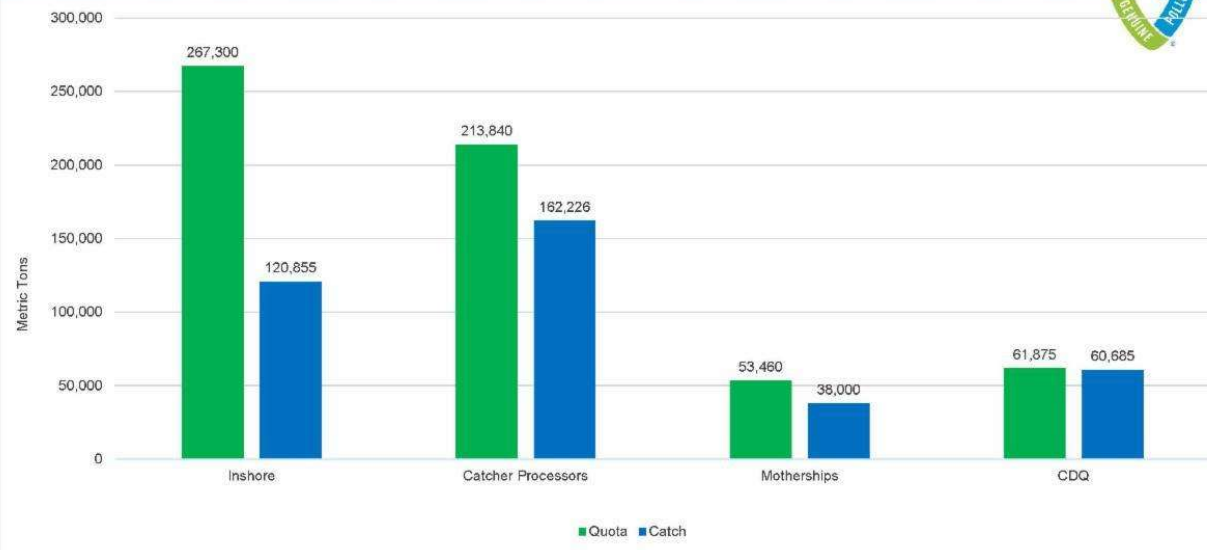

Listed below is some Bering Sea Pollock Information from the Genuine Alaska Pollock Producers website. I hope to have this type of information weekly for your review. Next week the North Pacific Fishery Management Council, April 5<sup>th</sup> with the Science Statistical Committee the Advisory Panel starts on Tuesday the 6<sup>th</sup> and the full Council state on Monday April 12<sup>th</sup> for the week. I will attach the schedule and full the agenda with this memo. The Council has some interesting reports being made under the B reports agenda item, the Navy will report on the Northern Edge Exercises in 2021, NMFS will do a briefing to the Council on Executive Order 14008 on the Climate Crisis, they will also update the Council on Seabird bycatch issues. Some of the major issues before the Council during the week include Halibut Abundance Based Management initial review, IFQ fishery access opportunities, Salmon bycatch, Pollock Cooperatives, Economic Data Reports, Research Priorities for the next three years, and the setting of the Scallop Fishery Allocations.

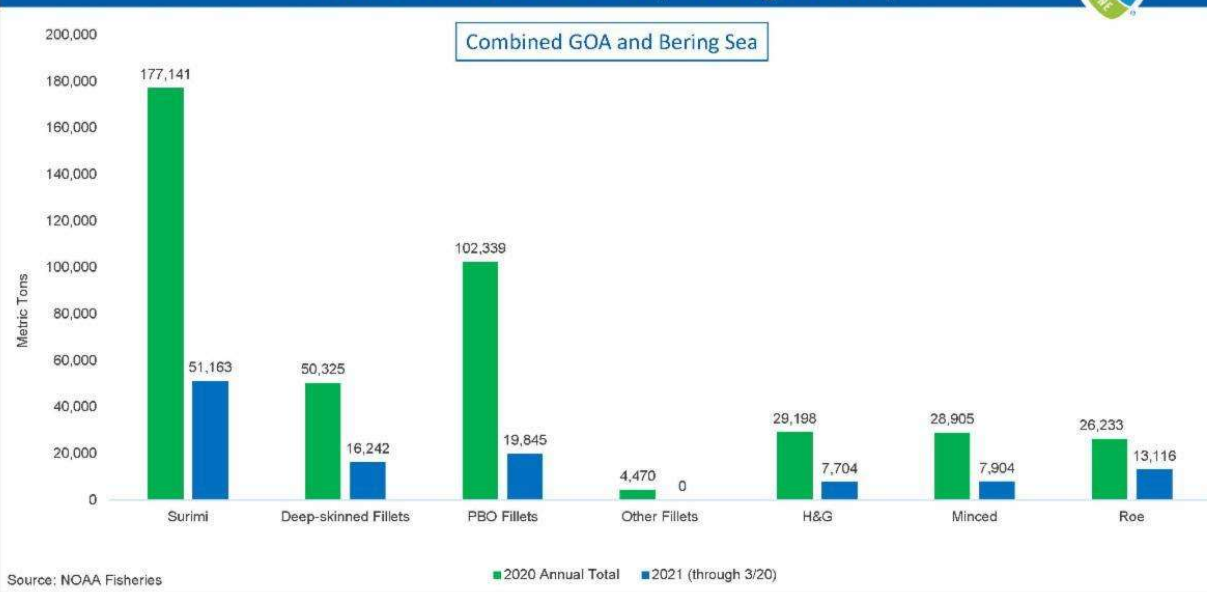


## Alaska Pollock 2021 A Season Catch as of 3/20.21 vs quota - Bering Sea
