10.040.060 BILLING AND COLLECTION B, RENDITION OF BILL. Bills shall be deemed rendered, and other notices duly given, when delivered to the customer, or seen left at either of such places. B. RESPONSIBILITY. Statements will be sent on a monthly basis and shall be due within 15 days of the billing date printed on the statements, provided that said bills are mailed on or before billing date.
