Monthly Report
July, 2013

Library use in July, 2013 totaled 11,314 patrons who checked out 24,137 items. Ninety-four Interlibrary Loan requests were originated by patrons. As of the end of the month 7,323 active library borrowers (who had used their library cards within the last 60 months) had been registered and 161 Reference Questions had been answered.

Online With Libraries statistics are being maintained for the OWL Project Staff. 6,661 OWL computer sessions were initiated during the month of July and 3,868 library patrons exclusively used computer-based resources.

The library recorded 48 hours of volunteer participation in public activity programming by 20 individuals during the month of July.

No major accidents or incidents took place at the library during the month of July.

The library deposited fines and fees totaling \$941.00 in July.

The staff marched in the July 4th Parade holding a great banner, "Dig Into Reading" designed by Peat Galaktionoff. Staff members are hanging leaves on the tree which now sprouts from the library Circulation Desk which denote program participants. Also, a garden now graces a wall of the Children's Room where kids can affix worms tracking their reading progress for the summer.

Sirsi/Dynix has completed installation of licensing necessary to allow e-book checkout through the library on-line catalog. Overdrive, the vendor supplying Listen Alaska with e-book and audio materials, has scheduled on-line training for the library staff in September.
