Unalaska Public Library -- Daniel Masoni, Librarian Monthly Report June, 2013

Library use in June, 2013 totaled 10,228 patrons who checked out 24,762 items. One Hundred-Forty Interlibrary Loan requests were originated by patrons. As of the end of the month 7,249 active library borrowers (who had used their library cards within the last 60 months) had been registered and 74 Reference Questions had been answered.

Online With Libraries statistics are being maintained for the OWL Project Staff. 6,914 OWL computer sessions were initiated during the month of June and 5,224 library patrons exclusively used computer-based resources.

The library recorded 34 hours of volunteer participation in public activity programming by 16 individuals during the month of June.

No major accidents or incidents took place at the library during the month of June.

The library deposited fines and fees totaling \$1,252.70 in June.

The staff marched in the July 4th Parade holding a great banner, "Dig Into Reading" designed by Peat Galaktionoff. Staff members are hanging leaves on the tree which now sprouts from the library Circulation Desk which denote program participants. Also, a garden now graces a wall of the Children's Room where kids can affix worms tracking their reading progress for the summer.

At the end of June, Sirsi/Dynix was contacted to begin the licensing procedures necessary to add Overdrive accessible e-books to the Library Catalog. That effort continues as this report is written.
