A RESOLUTION OF THE UNALASKA CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE PUBLIC WORKS AND PUBLIC UTILITIES CBA BETWEEN THE CITY OF UNALASKA AND INTERNATIONAL UNION OF OPERATING ENGINEERS, LOCAL 302

WHEREAS, the City and IUOE desire that the PW&PU CBA conform to the negotiated terms;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT THE UNALASKA CITY COUNCIL authorizes the City Manager to sign Amendment No. 1 to the PW&PU CBA.

# AMENDMENT NO 1. TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT FOR PUBLIC WORKS AND PUBLIC UTILITIES EMPLOYEES BETWEEN CITY OF UNALASKA AND IUOE 302

WHEREAS, the City of Unalaska ("the City") and the International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 302. ("302 IUOE") have entered into the Collective Bargaining Agreement for public works and public utility employees effective July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2022 ("PW&PU CBA"); and

WHEREAS, the City and 302 IUOE agree there were errors in transcribing the final PW&PU CBA prior to execution; and

WHEREAS, the City and 302 IUOE desire that the PW&PU CBA conform to the negotiated terms;

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Unalaska and 302 IUOE hereby agree as follows:

1. <u>Amendment to Paragraph 5.4(A): Dues Deductions</u>. Paragraph 5.4(A) of the PW&PU CBA is amended to read as follows (deleted terms are <u>struck</u>, new terms are <u>underlined</u>):

### 5.4 DUES DEDUCTIONS

- (A) Upon written authorization of an employee within the bargaining unit, the City shall deduct monthly from the payroll of the employee (i) the regular fixed monthly dues, assessments and fees of the Association, and/or (ii) any such other specific dollar amount as an employee may request in the written authorization provided to the Employer, and deliver said amount on behalf of the member to the agent of Local 302 on a monthly basis. Such authorization shall be revocable at any time by the employee in writing using a form supplied by the Employer. Deductions authorized shall be on a form mutually agreeable to the parties. The City will refer all employee inquiries regarding union membership or termination of membership to the appropriate Union. The City may answer any employee inquiry about payroll deductions.
- Amendment to Paragraph 17.1 Division of Classifications and Wages. Paragraph 17.1 of the PW&PU CBA is amended by replacing the table of Wages Effective July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 – June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022 with the following table:
