Overview:

Most of this week was busy with departmental subcommittee closeouts for House Finance. Those closeouts are anticipated to be complete next week. Standing committees are beginning to hear other bills and strategize on issues of interest for the remainder of the session, as we all know the elephant in the room is the Permanent Fund Dividend, the theories and ideas for resolution on this matter range far and wide.

Governor Dunleavy introduced a bill to initiate a state lottery this week. The bill would establish a lottery corporation that would have the authority to conduct any kind of lottery game, including in-state and multi-state draw games, such as Powerball or Mega Millions, scratch-offs, sports betting, and games through use of any media. At this point the estimated revenue is in the neighborhood of \$5-\$10 million. As more games are added that amount would grow. The bill will receive its first hearing this week. Alaska is one of five states that doesn't have a lottery. The bill is met with mixed feeling by legislators.

Friday the Alaska Supreme Court overturned previous rulings and will allow the signature gathering for the recall of the Governor to commence. The arguments over the legality of the recall is scheduled to take place March 25th.

In committee hearings this week:

- The Transportation subcommittee added \$18.7 million for AMHS operations.
- The Public Safety subcommittee added \$1.0 million for the VPSO program, to partially restore funds that were vetoed in FY20.
- House Energy heard HB 232- Municipal Tax Credits, which allows local governments to
 offer municipal tax credits for home and business owners who invest in property
 improvements which result in increased energy efficiency or improve local air quality.
 This bill does not mandate any action by municipalities. Public testimony will be
 Thursday February 20th (See details below).

- Senate Finance took up HB 106- School Bond Debit Reimbursement, which extends the current moratorium for an additional 5 years. This is problematic, currently there is zero funding for school construction or major maintenance in the Governors FY21 budget.
- SB 74- Internet for Schools, was passed out of House Finance and is currently in rules waiting the be scheduled on the House floor.

Keep in mind that any action by the subcommittees is subject to change as it is taken up in House Finance. Also, please note scheduled public testimony on the budget bills below.
