### **Overview:**

This week was all about subcommittee close outs and public testimony before House Finance on the operating budget. The process is moving much faster than last year and the House is striving to have the operating budget to the Senate the first week in March.

Sub-committee close out highlights include;

- Restoration of the Ocean Ranger program
- Funding for commercial shellfish PSP testing
- Restored cuts made to the Division of Commercial Fisheries
- Restored the Online with Libraries (OWL) program
- Allocated \$1 million for public broadcasting grants
- Added \$18.7 million to Alaska Marine Highway System

Remember, this is the beginning of the budget process, there are several iterations before we know if these changes will remain in the final budget proposed to the Governor.

The Governors deadline for submitting budget amendments was Wednesday. He proposed a number of amendments including restoration of the controversial \$334,700 to the appellate courts that he voted last year over the Supreme Court decisions on abortion, which he disagreed with.

The amendment most notable was the proposed supplemental check in the amount of \$1304.00 to retroactively pay all Alaskans the permanent fund dividend amount prescribed in the 1982 formula. This proposed supplemental would cost about \$815.9 million to be paid from the permanent fund earnings. This proposal does not appear to be popular with most Legislators.

The Governor also introduced <u>HB 270</u> / <u>SB 217</u>, would allow dividend-eligible Alaskans the option to receive a voucher worth twice the monetary value of the statutory dividend calculation

to be applied toward purchase of state land. The PFD land vouchers would be transferable, would not expire, could be combined for purchase of a single parcel, and could be used along with the state veterans' land sales programs.

Also introduced by the Governor was a States lands bill which would seek to open up state lands for sale and development. The bill would create a new statute for leasing state lands for commercial or industrial development, reverse regulations designating certain rivers in Southcentral as "recreation" waters in an effort to open up such areas to sales and development and allow the state additional power in constructing access roads related to state land sales.

House Republicans voted to confirm Glenn "Mike" Prax to a seat vacated when longtime Rep. Tammie Wilson resigned last month.

Senator Bishops motor fuel tax bill passed out of Senate Finance on Friday and will head to the full Senate for a vote before being passed over to the House.
