<u>City of Unalaska Legislative Report</u> 1/29/21

The Legislature continues to be off to a very slow start, particularly the House of Representatives. They remain unorganized and are split 20/20, they have even been unsuccessful in electing a pro tem speaker. Nominations have been made twice and both times the vote was 20/20, which results in a failed vote. This puts them in a position where absolutely no work can be conducted.

The Senate Finance committee started holding committee hearings this week, primarily with overviews from the Department of Natural Resources, Office of Management and Budget and the Department of Revenue. As you can imagine, the focus is on the operation and capital budgets along with the deficit facing the State.

Both of the Senate Finance Co-chairs have signaled a desire to get the budget process completed by mid-March and perhaps work on personal legislation over the interim or reconvene once more folks are vaccinated, eliminating the strict testing and limited access requirements currently in place at the Capitol Building.

Governor Dunleavy gave the State of the State address in a live broadcast from Anchorage Thursday evening, the first time the speech hasn't been given in person. While there was not much in breaking news, he discussed the need to become more self-reliant and has charged his administration with researching how Alaskans can become more self-reliant within the framework of federalism.

The governor pushed back against federal regulation of Alaska's lands, saying the state had a constitutional obligation to develop its resources. He said the state's potential to generate its own energy is unlimited and his administration will pursue alternative forms of energy such a tidal and geothermal, while at the same time he reaffirmed the state's commitment to fossil fuels.

A large portion of his speech focused on the need for economic recovery. He reiterated his previous proposal for a \$5 billion draw from the Earnings Reserve Account to pay large Permanent Fund Dividend checks. He also supports bringing gambling to the state to create revenue.
