## City of Unalaska Legislative Report 1/31/22

Last week saw plenty of finance sub-committee hearings and more presentations on the Governors proposed budget from both the Office of Management and Budget and Legislative Finance.

The Governor delivered his 4<sup>th</sup> the State of the State last Tuesday which was very optimistic regarding the State's fiscal future. With oil prices hoovering in the higher \$80 per barrel and high market performance, this year's budgeting will not compare to the previous years where we started with a huge deficit.

The Governor indicated that he envisioned the state being a leader in renewable energy, providing energy costs among the lowest in the nation. He also talked about developing the vast stores of natural gas on the North Slope, although no detail was provided on how that would be realized.

The General Obligation Bond bills were heard in Senate Transportation (SB 166) and House Finance (HB 285), based on the questions and comments, there is plenty of work to be done before any possible movement.

With several Legislators and Staff out sick over the last week, it is unclear when the finance sub committees will wrap up, once that occurs, we will likely see things start moving at a faster pace.
