Item 1:

PROJECT MANUAL, Section 00030 INVITATION TO BID:

The bid advertisement period is being extended one week.

Item 2:

Electric light poles are being added to UCSD Park as an Additive Alternate. The Contract Documents are changed as follows:

- Item 2.1: PLAN SET, Replace Plan Sheet No. 6 of 30, UCSD PARK DEVELOPMENT & LAYOUT PLAN with the attached revised sheet. Three light poles, a load center and and electrical conduit/conductors were added to the development plan.
- Item 2.2: PLAN SET, *Add Plan Sheet No.* 15.1 of 31, **UCSD PARK ADD. ALT 2 LIGHT POLES**. The added sheet is attached to this addendum. The sheet provides details for the light poles and associated electrical work.
- Item 2.3: PLAN SET, All Sheets; Change Sheet Nos. X of 30 to Sheet Nos. X of 31.
- Item 2.4: PLAN SET, Sheet 1 of 30 (now 31) COVER SHEET: Add "15.1 UCSD PARK ADD. ALT 2 LIGHT POLES" to Sheet Index.
- Item 2.5: PROJECT MANUAL, Section 00300 BID FORM, Replace pages 00300-1 through 00300-10 with the attached Revised Section. The revised forms add Additive Alternate 2, Light Poles.

This Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed person, firm, or corporation and is not submitted in conformity with any agreement or rules of any group, association, organization, or corporation; Bidder has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other Bidder to submit a false or sham Bid; Bidder has not solicited or induced any person, firm, or corporation to refrain from bidding; and Bidder has not sought by collusion to obtain for itself any advantage over any other Bidder or over the City.

In submitting this Bid, Bidder represents, as more fully set forth in the Agreement, that Bidder has examined copies of all the Bidding Documents.

Bidder has familiarized itself with the nature and extent of the Contract Documents, work, site, locality, general nature of work to be performed by Owner or others at the site that relates to work for which this Bid is submitted as indicated in the Contract Documents, and all local conditions and all federal, state, and local Laws and Regulations that in any manner may affect cost, progress, performance, or furnishing of the work.

Bidder has reviewed and checked all information and data shown or indicated in the Contract Documents with respect to existing Underground Facilities at or contiguous to the site and assumes responsibility for the accurate location of said Underground Facilities. 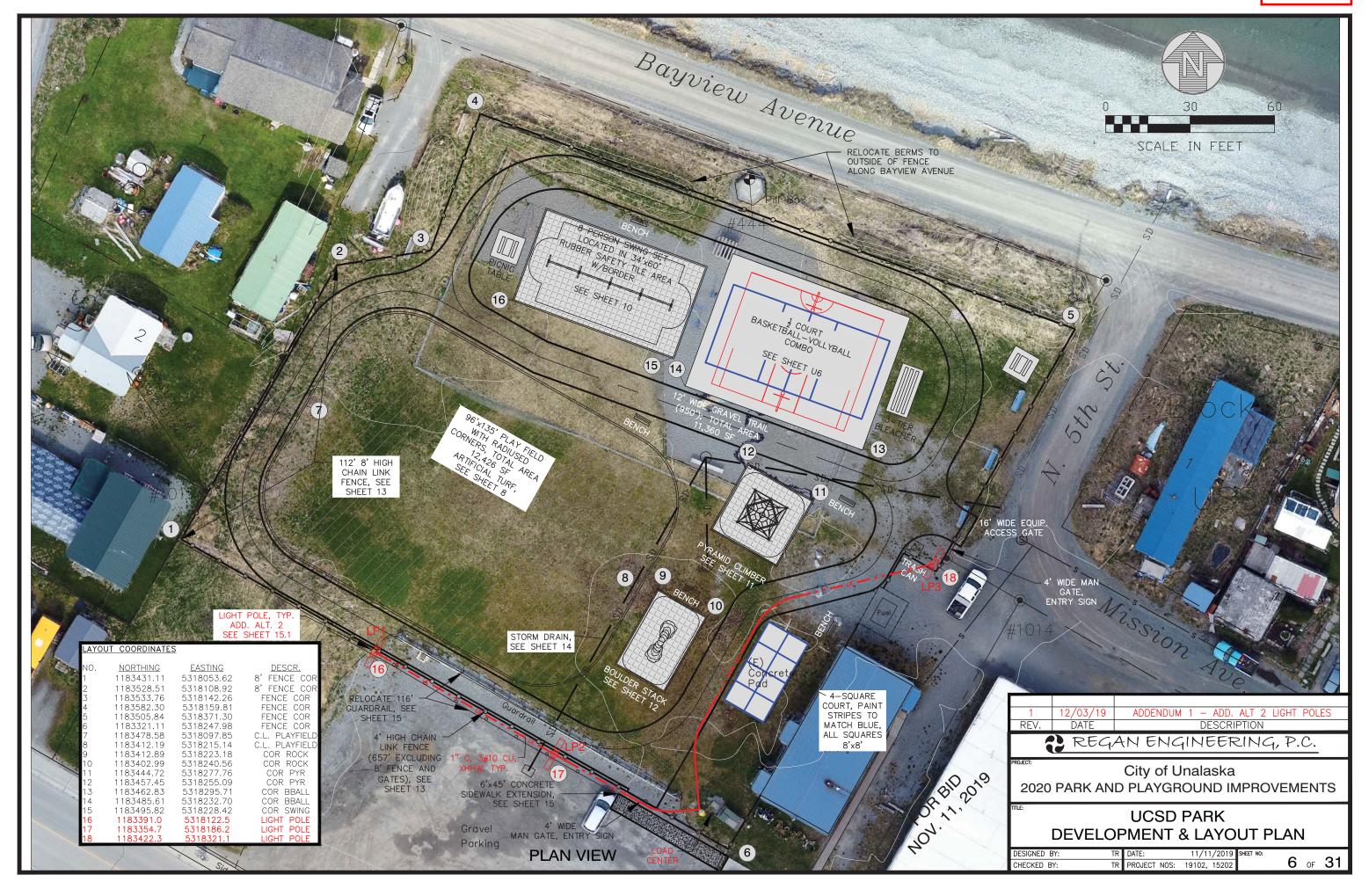

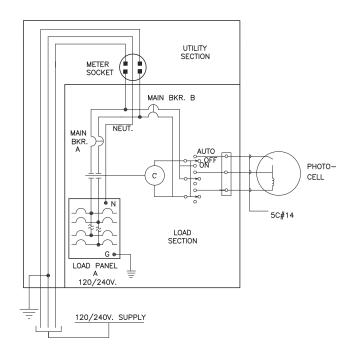

- 2. LUMINAIRES: LOW-PROFILE ALUMINUM AREA LIGHT, TYPE 3 DISTRIBUTION, 525 mA DRIVER, SILVER HOUSING, BETA LED #ARE-EDG-3M-DA-10-D-UL-SV-525, 172 WATTS LED, UNIVERSAL VOLTAGE ELECTRONIC DRIVER. PROVIDE TWO LUMINAIRES PER POLE AT 180-DEGREES.
- 3. COMPLY WITH THE LATEST ADOPTED EDITION OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE, INTERNATIONAL BUILDING CODE, THE INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE, AND LOCAL AMENDMENTS TO THESE CODES. COMPLY WITH THE LATEST PUBLISHED VERSION OF THE NECA STANDARD OF INSTALLATION.

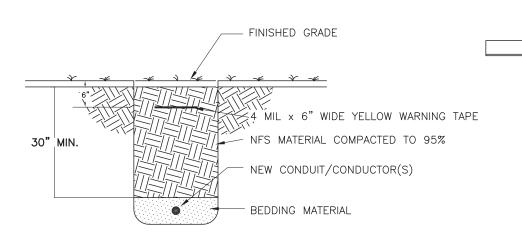

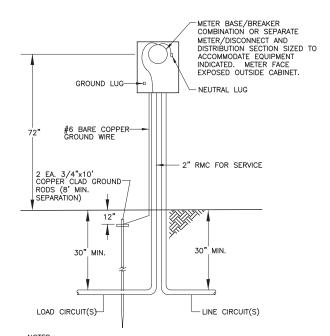
LOAD CENTER ONE-LINE DIAGRAM

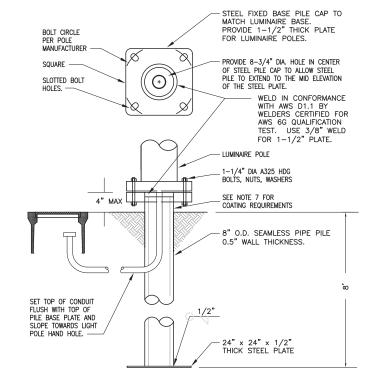
