MANAGER'S REPORT: City Manager Chris Hladick reported the following:

- The City Manager attended the Institute of the North conference on the commercial development of the Arctic. He is working with the Museum of the Aleutians to set up a presentation for the public.
- The City Manager gave an update on what the community might expect this summer with the presence of Shell Oil.
- Bob Herron, who will, most likely, be the City of Unalaska's legislative representative following redistricting, and Lyman Hoffman will visit Unalaska the first week in June.

#### **COMMUNITY INPUT/ANNOUNCEMENTS:**

- 1. Community Clean-Up Week began yesterday, May 7th.
- 2. Ballyhoo Lions Club Memorial Day service will be held at Memorial Park at 11:00 a.m. on Memorial Day. In memory of the 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the bombing of Unalaska, the Lions Club has acquired two flags that were flown over the USS Arizona. One of the flags raised at the Memorial Day service will be sent to the World War II Veterans Memorial, and the other flag will be given to the Museum of the Aleutians.
- 3. Lynda Lybeck-Robinson's students will participate in a piano recital from 2:00 to 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 13<sup>th</sup> at the school auditorium.

## **PUBLIC TESTIMONY ON AGENDA ITEMS**

Vince Tutiakoff, member of the Board of Directors of the Ounalashka Corporation, First Chief of the Qawalangin Tribe, President of the Unalaska Native Fishermen Association, and Ballyhoo Lions Club member, spoke to Ordinance 2012-02, supporting subsistence and preservation of the ecosystem.

Tom Robinson, member of the Board of Directors of the Unalaska Native Fishermen Association and Qawalangin Tribe, spoke on behalf of his sister Rufina who opposes any kind of development in the Captains Bay tidelands. He asked that the City assist landowners in finding grants to help with cleaning the environment.

Dustin Dickerson, Vice President of the Unalaska Native Fishermen Association, indicated that he is pro-development, but would like to see the City Council mitigate some of the environmental issues in Captains Bay, such as reintroducing some of the indigenous species into the river.

Bill Shaishnikoff, whose family owns property in the area, spoke in favor of changing the zoning for future development.

Wendy Svarny-Hawthorne, CEO of the Ounalashka Corporation, spoke to the value of protecting wildlife and subsistence, and also noted the importance of planned, responsible development.
