- **Confirmed cases**
 - **Current: 0**
 - Cumulative since 1/1/2020: 0
- **Persons Under Investigation (PUI)***
 - **Current: 16 (pending tests)**
 - Cumulative since 1/1/2020: 47 (includes negative and pending tests)

SYMPTOMS

Main symptoms:

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of Breath

More rare symptoms:

- Nausea
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea

Help prevent the spread of respiratory diseases like COVID-19.

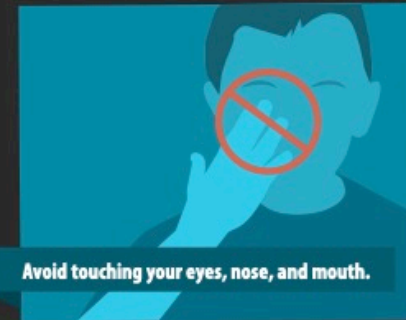
Avoid close contact with people who are sick.

Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.



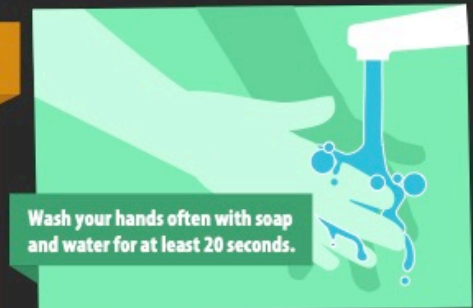
Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.

Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.

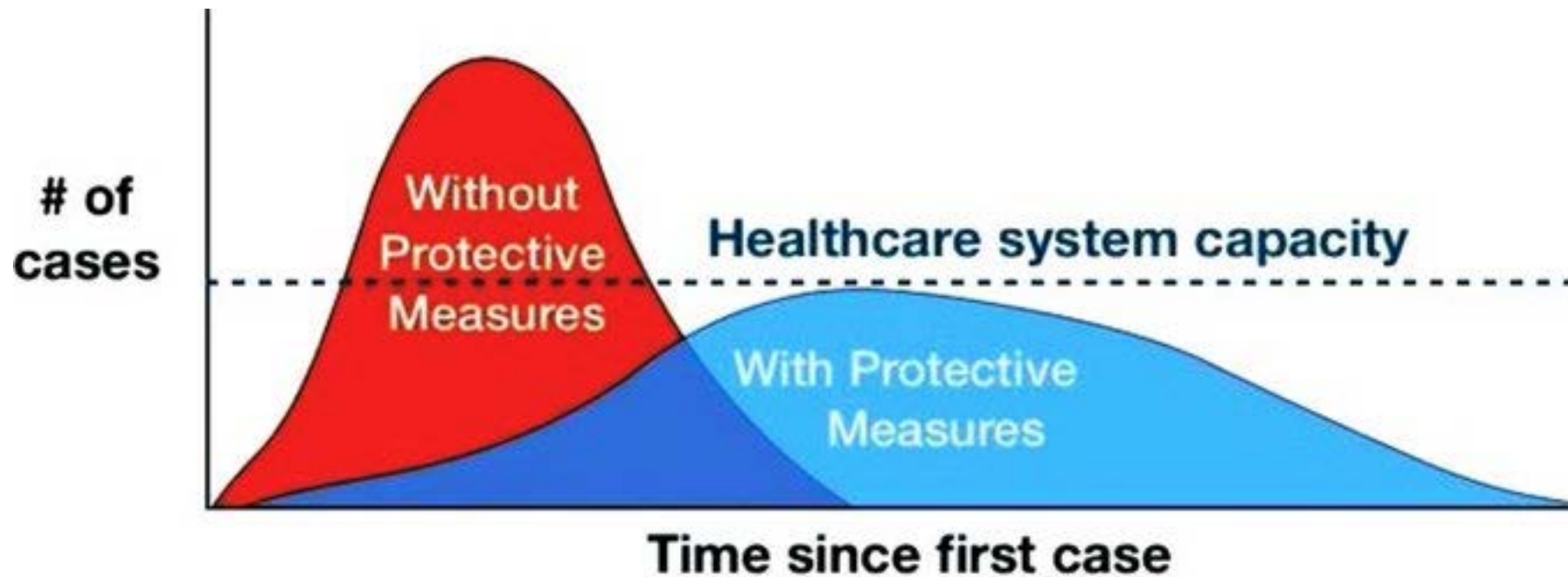

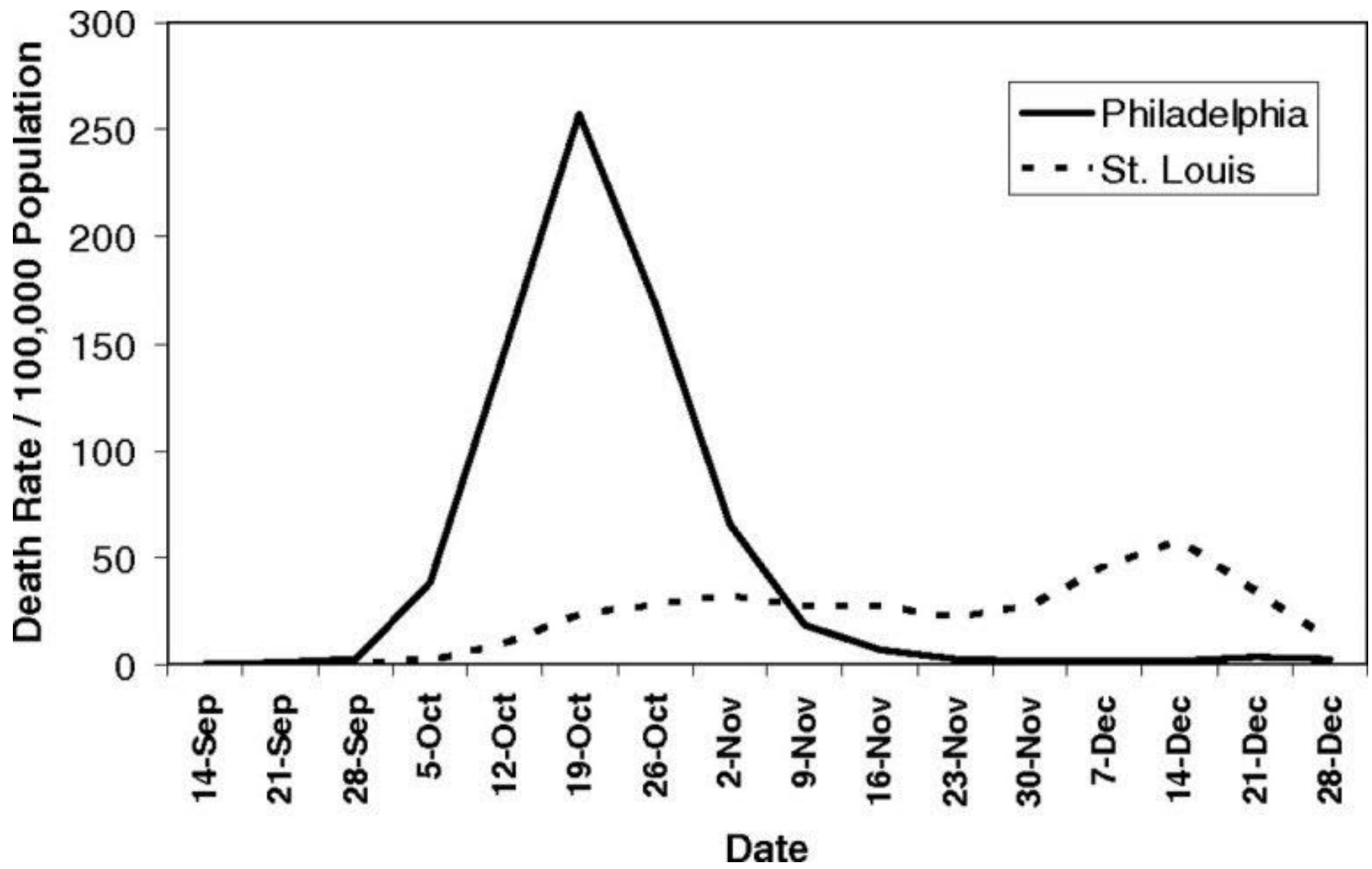
PREVENTION MEASURES
